

Guidelines for Visitors and Tours

Thank you for your interest in Glacial Lakes Energy, LLC. We are committed to maintaining a safe, healthy environment for our employees and visitors.

- 1. All visitors/tour groups must register at the Administration Office. No visitors are allowed beyond the Administration Office without permission from the Administration Office.
- 2. Visitors/Tour Representatives will be requested to read and sign a Waiver. As a Visitor(s)/Tour Representative, you are accepting full responsibility for the safety of all members of your tour group.
- 3. Disruptive or non-accommodating visitors will be escorted to the main office and may be asked to leave.
- 4. No smoking or open flames are permitted throughout the entire facility.
- 5. Should an emergency arise during your tour follow the instructions from your tour leader.
- 6. Children under the age of 12 will not be allowed to tour the facility due to liability reasons. Children under the age of 18 must have one adult for every 5 children.
- 7. GLE will divide the group into appropriate sizes as deemed necessary.
- 8. Stay together with the group. Your tour leader will stop frequently and provide you time to ask questions.
- 9. You may be required to wear hard hat and safety glasses with side shields, which GLE will provide.
- 10. No open-toed shoes or high heeled shoes—prefer low heel tennis shoe style.
- 11. You must wear pants (shorts or cut offs will **NOT** be permitted). Shirts are required.
- 12. Do not touch any equipment, machinery, process equipment, chemicals, etc unless you receive permission from the tour guide to do so.
- 13. Watch out for hoses, electrical cords, pallets, and any other obstructions that may present a trip hazard.
- 14. Do not enter caution taped (red and/or yellow) areas under any circumstances.
- 15. During the tour you may be required to walk over steps, uneven terrain and gratings that may present a trip hazard.
- 16. You may be exposed to high levels of noise in various locations of the plant
- 17. You may be exposed to various non-hazardous odors.
- 18. You will be exposed to truck traffic in certain locations.
- 19. You may encounter the following allergens:
 - a. High level of corn dust in various areas
 - b. Penicillin
 - c. Virginia Mycin
 - d. Terramycin
 - e. Other natural pollens

20. You will need to be observant of overhead work areas and low hanging physical obstructions such as piping, etc.
