

Purpose: GLE provides freight incentives on a member's committed bushels. The purpose of this policy is to provide discipline and structure around the contracting and payment of the freight amounts related to the delivery of these bushels.

- GLE has established a freight incentive schedule for deliveries of committed bushels by its members. See attached addendum.
- Freight will be calculated and paid on member's committed bushels based upon a member's home farm address or point of origin of corn to the GLE facility at time of delivery.
- Freight incentives will only be paid on deliveries related to the member's corn commitment. Bushels delivered in excess of the member's corn commitment will not be eligible for the freight incentive.
- Corn deliveries made on behalf of a member's committed bushels by related parties will remain eligible for freight incentives under the GLCP freight incentive policy, as determined by GLCP on a case-by-case basis.
 - For purposes of this freight policy and corn deliveries of a member's committed bushels eligible for freight incentives, related parties of the member shall mean:
 - Spouse;
 - Parent (including step & in-laws);
 - Children (including step and adopted);
 - Grandparents (including step & in-laws)
 - Brothers and Sisters (including step, half, & in-laws);
 - Nieces and Nephews;
 - Aunts and Uncles;
 - Members of a family farm, a family farm corporation or an authorized farm corporation member that is exempt from corporate farming restrictions under the SD corporate farming laws;
 - Nonprofit corporations that are engaged in farming and agricultural operations; and
 - Shareholders, investors, partners or other beneficial owners of non-individual memberships
- Corn deliveries of a member's committed bushels by non-related parties or commercial type entities such as elevators, licensed grain buyers, brokers, etc. will not be eligible for freight incentives.
- Members will be required to identify and designate related parties to GLCP for purposes of this policy. A current Third-Party Delivery Form (attached) must be completed and on file with GLCP for each member for whom corn deliveries of a member's committed bushels by related parties will be made. Until the aforementioned form is received by GLE, a freight incentive cannot be paid.
- It is the responsibility of the member to notify GLE at the time of contracting for a third-party delivery in order for the delivery to be applied to their membership and committed bushels and to become eligible for the freight incentive.

- Corn contracts will be issued in the member's name per the GLCP stock certificate registration name and mailed to the corresponding address on file.
- Checks will be issued in the member's name per the contract followed by the third party's name and any lien holders. Lienholders for all parties will be included on the check. Payment will be mailed unless other arrangements are made.
- GLCP reserves the right to accept or reject a member designation at its sole discretion.
- GLE reserves the right to review freight incentives at their discretion and freight incentive/reimbursement rates are subject to elimination, change or modification by the Board of Directors in their sole discretion, with or without notice.

GLCP Third Party Delivery Form

Reference is made to the Member's Uniform Marketing and Delivery Agreement (UMDA) and the GLCP Membership Freight Policy made thereunder.

- Purpose.** The purpose of this form is to allow the member to designate third parties that the member certifies are "related parties" for purposes of the GLCP Membership Freight Policy. Member understands that the GLCP Membership Freight Policy under the UMDA is subject to change from time to time in the sole discretion of the board of directors, and that freight incentives and transportation allowances are not guaranteed. Member understands that the determination of a related party for purposes of the GLCP Membership Freight Policy will be determined by the board of directors of GLCP or its authorized agent Glacial Lakes Energy, LLC in their sole discretion, on a case-by-case basis.
- Related Parties.** Member understands that "related parties" under the GLCP Membership Freight Policy means: (i) Spouse; Parent (including step); Children (including step and adopted); Grandparent (including step & in-laws); Brothers and Sisters (including step, half, & in-laws); Nieces and Nephews; Aunts and Uncles; (ii) Members of a family farm, a family farm corporation, or an authorized farm corporation member that is exempt under the SD corporate farming laws, (iii) Nonprofit corporations that are engaged in farming and agricultural operations, and (iv) Shareholders, investors, partners, or other beneficial owners of non-individual GLCP memberships; each as determined by GLCP on a case-by-case basis in its sole discretion.
- Member Certification.** Under the penalties of perjury, the undersigned Member hereby certifies that the following individuals and entities are related parties to the member within the above definition:
