

## Join Us for Yellow Dime Day & E 15 Day

**Glacial Lakes Energy, LLC Will Host a Local Event to Celebrate Ethanol's Impact on the Economy and Raise Awareness of the Need to Move up from E10 to E15!**

Local businesses are teaming up in support of ethanol this week, to celebrate ethanol's contribution to the local economy and to raise public awareness for the need to move to E15 as the new base blend of ethanol and gasoline.

**“Yellow Dime Day Wednesday” will be hosted at Sioux Valley Coop C Store on east Hwy 212 in Watertown on May 15. Between the hours of 11:00 a.m. and 1:00 p.m., customers will receive up to \$0.40 cents off each gallon of ethanol-blended fuel they purchase.**

In addition, a petition can be signed by those in favor of the EPA approving E15 as the new base fuel blend. The online version of the petition, found at <http://www.goe15.com> has gathered more than 4,900 signatures in one month.

The U.S. Environmental Protection Agency is currently considering a waiver to change the 30-year-old regulation limiting the ethanol content per gallon to just 10 percent. Allowing up to 15 percent ethanol per gallon would boost South Dakota's economy by opening up a new market for ethanol produced here and offering motorists more clean, cost-effective fuel.
