**Now Accepted: Syngenta Agrisure Viptera<sup>®</sup> Corn**

Glacial Lakes Energy, LLC (GLE) is now accepting Syngenta Agrisure Viptera corn at all locations. GLE stopped taking deliveries of this hybrid, as well as Syngenta Agrisure Duracade™, back in May of 2014. This was due to China's rejection of corn cargoes carrying these two traits.

GLE has a heavy market dependence on exports of dried distillers grain (DDG) to the Pacific Rim and China. China would not accept DDGs processed from corn with the MIR 162 trait. To remain viable for exporting, GLE must limit the processing of corn to hybrids approved for export markets. With China's decision to lift the ban on Viptera corn, GLE will now accept deliveries for this hybrid.

GLE is still unable to accept Syngenta Agrisure Duracade. China has not approved the use of this hybrid, therefore, it cannot be delivered to processing plants that serve export markets or to grain elevators that serve these plants.
